There are many things that we need to pray for. The Blessed Virgin Mary ask the children at Fatima to tell people to pray and fast:

"Pray, pray much, and sacrifice for sinners, for many souls go to hell because there is no one to sacrifice and pray for them." ([Fourth Apparition](#) of Our Lady of Fatima – August 19, 1917)

However, you choose to fast, unite your thoughts and prayers before the Lord for the protection of the Church, families, and peace in the world – especially for the people of Ukraine.
