









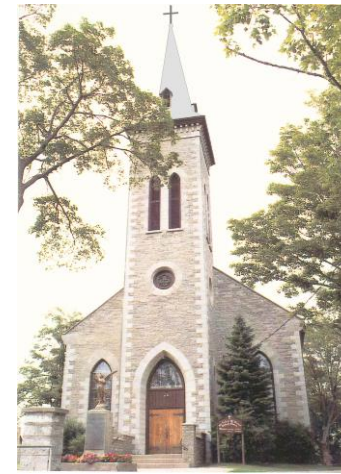

"In the climate which is not that of life and mercy, but of death and condemnation, the personal and collective guilt of [people] and of groups wrestle with one another in death struggle. The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary – August 15th
